# 3. Purpose and legal basis on which we process personal data

#### 3.1 Call XING profil

For the information service offered here, we use the technical platform and services of New Work SE, Am Strandkai 1, 20457 Hamburg. For this purpose, we have entered into an agreement with the provider regarding the processing of your data, which forms the basis of the contractual rights of use by us.

We would like to point out that you use our XING site and its functions on your own responsibility. This applies in particular to the use of the interactive functions (e.g. networking, sharing, rating). Alternatively, you can also access the information offered via this page on our website at <a href="https://www.leukhardt.de">https://www.leukhardt.de</a>.

When you use XING and are on the platform, XING will collect and use personal information such as your IP address as well as other information that is also available in the form of cookies on your PC. This information is also used to provide us, as the operator of our company page on XING, with statistical information about the use of our presence. The contents of these evaluations are exclusively anonymous. Under no circumstances can we establish a connection to your person.

The data collected about you in this context will be processed by New Work SE and, if necessary, transferred to countries outside the European Union. What information New Work SE receives and how it is used is described in general terms by the provider in its privacy policy. In what way New Work SE uses the data from a visit to our company page on XING for its own purposes, to what extent activities on the page are assigned to individual users, how long New Work



SE stores this data and whether data from a visit to our company page is passed on to third parties, is not conclusively and clearly stated by New Work SE. We have no knowledge about this.

If you are currently logged in to XING as a user, a cookie with your XING ID is stored on your end device. This enables New Work SE to track that you have visited this page and how you have used it. This also applies to all other XING pages. Via XING buttons embedded in websites, it may be possible for New Work SE to record your visits to these websites and assign them to your XING profile. If you wish to avoid this, you should log out of XING or deactivate the "stay logged in" function, delete the cookies present on your device and close your browser and then restart it. In this way, XING information by which you can be directly identified will be deleted. This allows you to use our XING site without revealing your XING identifier. When you access interactive features of the site (networking, commenting, sharing, news, etc.), a XING login screen will appear. After any login, you will again be recognizable to XING as a specific user.

# 4. Who will get to see your data?

Personal data that you publish as part of the use of interactive functions (e.g. networking, commenting, sharing, rating) are openly visible to visitors of the corresponding platforms on the Internet. Beyond that, we do not transmit or otherwise disclose any personal data to third parties.

# 5. Your data protection rights

We have defined processes within our company so that you can exercise your rights with us. You have a right to,

- revoke your consent at any time with effect for the future (Art.7 para. 3 GDPR).
- to receive information (Art.15 GDPR) about your data stored by us.
- that incorrect data about you will be corrected by us (Art.16 GDPR).
- that we delete data about you that is no longer required (Art.17 GDPR).
- that under certain conditions the processing of your data is restricted (Art.18 GDPR). This may be the case, for example, if deletion is not possible, but the data may not be processed further.
- That your data is transferable (Art. 20 GDPR). This right applies in particular if you have given your consent to the processing of your data or if the processing of the data is necessary to fulfill a contract. The right to data portability does not exist insofar as your data is not processed using automated procedures.



- to object to the further processing of your personal data in a special situation (Art. 21 GDPR), insofar as the processing is based on the legitimate interest (Art.6 para.1 lit.f GDPR) as well as in the case of profiling based on this. You may also object at any time if the data is used for direct marketing purposes (Art. 21 (2) GDPR).
- to complain to a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR) if you are of the opinion that the processing of your data violates the legal requirements. The supervisory authority responsible for us is:
